More Amazing Programs

Special Needs campers are invited to join the resident camp program during **July 12-18 and/or July 19-25**. This is a fully integrated, mainstream experience in a resident camper population of 250, limited to 15 special needs children, ages 8-21 or still attending high school. Campers must be able to care for themselves with limited assistance. All resident camp activities are available to all campers during these weeks. Contact Bonnie at ext. 221.



Music Camp is one of the options for campers during the final week of camp, **August 16-22**. Throughout the week, campers learn a variety of songs which are performed at a concert on Friday night. Instrumentalists are encouraged to bring their instruments and be part of "the band". All other camp options are available to campers this week. Leadership Training Programs: Leadership Training Programs are an opportunity for a select group of people to take part in outstanding events of leadership training and development. Program lengths vary. Your program will afford you many opportunities to gain experience by actually doing things staff members customarily do. Applicants must be 16 years of age within the calendar year of service. Preference is given to those who have completed at least grade 10. Contact Kris at ext. 210.

Calumet Day Camp: For kids ages 6-14, day camp runs Monday-Friday. Come for one week or all eight. Lunch is provided. The day's activities include daily Bible discovery, swim lessons, crafts, games, story time, sing-a-longs, and more. Contact Alice at ext. 220.

- 🏠 Calumet is a residential camp for girls and boys ages 8-18.
- 🏠 For 49 summers, excited campers have arrived at Calumet to find experienced and well-trained counselors waiting for them. Most were campers themselves. Many are certified in CPR and First Aid. All of them love kids!
- 🏠 There are two counselors in every cabin or platform tent of 6-10 campers. All cabins and tents have bunk beds and electricity.
- 🏠 *Here to Serve* is the curriculum theme for 2009.
- 🏠 At Calumet, it's through fun activities such as sailing, hiking, and pottery that counselors have been helping campers listen to God's call in their daily lives. Daily Discovery Time and Vespers offer more intentional learning experiences. At Calumet, campers grow in faith, strengthened by the knowledge that they are a child of God.
- 🏠 Bus transportation is provided from Newington, CT, Vernon, CT, Worcester, MA, and Waltham, MA. You can sign up for the bus when you complete the Summer Camp Packet. Cost for the bus will be announced in that packet.
- 🏠 Payment plans are available for deposits. Contact Bonnie at ext. 221.
- 🏠 Rev. Dr. Nancy Eldredge Hess, Calumet's Executive Director, has served in many areas of ministry in the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America for 27 years before coming to Calumet in 2006.
- 🏠 Karl Ogren has served as Director for Children & Youth programs for 15 years. Karl makes sure that campers are safe and have an excellent camping experience.

OUTDOOR ADVENTURE CAMPS

Adventure Day Trip Series, June 28-July 4: Rock climb, kayak, canoe, hike, and bike. Stay at Calumet and set out from camp each day for a new adventure and return for evening programs and swimming in Ossipee Lake.

Advanced Summit Adventure, August 9-15: For campers who have wilderness experience. Climb a 4,000 footer. Experience some of the most beautiful trails from Mt. Lafayette to Mt. Washington. Set up camp. Go swimming in a waterfall. Cook your own meals. Walk the ridge above tree line and see the best view of your life.
