NEWINGTON BUS INFORMATION

Transportation will be provided by Commercial Bus Line and/or Calumet's vans. Every effort is made to assure comfort, safety, and happiness of campers taking advantage of this service. Calumet staff will accompany campers on the ride both to and from Camp.

- Prescribed medications will be checked in before boarding the bus. Please put original prescription containers in a zip-lock bag and label with the name of the camper, name of the medication, frequency of administration, and reason for the prescription. Please note that New Hampshire State law prohibits use of any drug not prescribed by a physician, so do not send vitamins, aspirin, etc., unless prescribed.
- Please pack a box lunch for the trip to camp.
- On the bus, our counselors will supervise and care for all the campers as if they were already at camp. They will make sure that everyone stays seated whenever the bus is in motion; no roughhousing will be allowed, and in general, all rules of good behavior that are normal at camp will be in effect on the bus.

DEPARTURE FROM NEWINGTON SUNDAY IS 8:45 AM

The bus will leave from the parking lot of [Our Savior's Lutheran Church](#), 1655 Main Street, Newington, Connecticut and will return to the same place on Saturday. You should arrive at the church no later than 8:30 a.m. on Sunday. **The bus will leave at 8:45 a.m. and will not wait if you are late.**

ARRIVAL BACK IN NEWINGTON SATURDAY IS 1:15 PM

Please be on time. Do not be alarmed if the bus is a little late, as it is difficult to estimate the traffic on the roads from Calumet. We will try to contact the church if the bus is expected to be more than one hour late.
